Selected applicants will be invited to return for a personal interview. If you are chosen, you will receive a telephone call to advise you of the date and time of your interview.

- Copy of your high school transcript or college Academic Upgrading transcript if you have not yet completed your OSSD or GED
- Any reference or recommendations letters from employers or instructors in a related field
- Resume
- Social Insurance Number
- Most recent tax assessment documentation (2009)

Acceptance is based on a combination of your assessment results and the personal interview!
